We want to bring family and friends together doing things they enjoy!

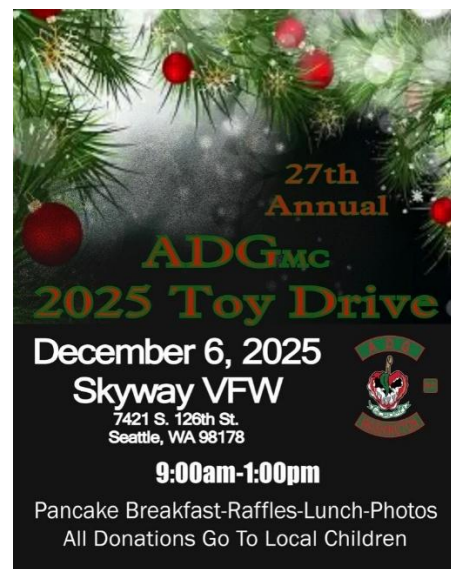
